

1) **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm

2) **Seating of Alternates**

4) **Planning**

A few important notes before talk on planning were:

- a) Jim created a display for Nahaco on Eastford Heritage Day to promote the park.
- b) He also spoke with the editor for the Woodstock Villager, Adam Miner. Adam has given the commission the opportunity to write its own articles however he will review them. The commission may also request for an interview.
- c) Both building inspectors were to be at the park for 3:30 on July 23rd.

Jim and Denis will head a subcommittee to find out more information about the cost of repairing the water pump by talking to a plumber. The commission has agreed to use the last green valley \$2,000 grant for the pump. The Grant is given out to organizations trying to preserve pieces of CT's history. Kim will write the grant and present it to the commission before submission.

Chris Mayhew had a crew of 6 on Sunday the 26th from 9-1pm for fixing up the kemosabe cabin. He is bringing the 9 mattresses from the cabin to the Woodstock Transfer Station. He estimates that half of the building will get finished.

Jim says that while inspecting the park, Dick Baron suggests putting resources into buildings that are already in good shape to make them better. I.e. Caretaker's Cabin, Dining hall, Waterfront Cabin. He says that these buildings have the potential to make the commission money.

The commission agrees the caretaker's cabin must be upgraded in order to draw in more qualified candidates.

The commission also agrees that the caretaker must pay a monthly fee of \$100 as well as complete 40 hours/month worth of work.

Kim has a propane heater for the caretaker's cabin but it must be installed by a licensed contractor.
