 - a. Report on Summer Programs

 - Volleyball – 46 participants. Donation to WA Booster for \$100 volleyball camp.
 - Swimming Lessons – Only 6 registered. Will promote the YMCA swim lessons next year due to low participation and multitude of schedule options the Y offers.
 - Zumba – 16 attended, 13 for fall. Bring a friend was success.
 - Twilight Summer Concerts – 2 concerts used rain dates. Blackburns on 7/28, 298 attended. Little Big Bank 343, Beck n Call 8/25 299 attended
 - Essentrics – great session, positive feedback from everyone. Charges are now \$2 for Woodstock seniors, \$3 for out of town seniors.
 - b. Report on Current Fall Programs

 - d. Report on WMS Tennis Courts – Diane is revitalizing the effort for this. Highway dept will be taking fence down repairs that will cost the Town at least \$7k.
