The Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International (PATH Intl.) promotes safety and optimal outcomes in equine-assisted activities and therapies for individuals with special needs. The organization and its dedicated members have since developed a multitude of different equine-related activities for therapeutic purposes, collectively known as equine-assisted activities and therapies (or EAAT).

P.A.T.H. Int'l and the Wounded Warrior Project (WWP) have allied to provide up to 10 weeks per veteran per semester at \$100 per lesson with confirmed attendance. P.A.T.H. is seeking 10 eligible veterans to begin training in January 2016. P.A.T.H. Int'l has scholarship funds for distribution to Premier Accredited Centers exclusively for WWP alumni members. Eligibility: Must be Post-9/11 and able to stand independently with prosthetics for 3-5 minutes, able to sit erect with/without prosthetics and minimal support for a 30-minute minimum.

Requirements: Must be registered with WWP (can be done online at <https://woundedwarriorproject.org/connect/AlumniRegistration.aspx>). Must complete pre- and post-session Quality of Life (QOL) surveys and weekly attendance records.
