

## Woodstock Recreation Commission – Meeting Minutes

1. Call to order 7:45pm
2. Approval of minutes from November. Motion to accept by Jen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sarah. Unanimously passed
3. Recreation Director Report
  - a. Ski Club -101 registered. Snow day this week due to icy conditions. Will use build in make- up day on 2/14. The new bus company is still great! Ski Coordinator (Middle school teacher) is an asset to the program. We pay her now and may want to consider an increase next year.
  - b. Basketball – higher number of participants in K-4 grades. Lots of walk in registrations again this year. We should review the policy before next year’s season. Potential use of Hyde next year may help with increased interest in the program.
  - c. Senior fitness is still very popular 2x/week. Currently a free program until June. We will possibly charge \$2/class when it picks up again in the fall
  - d. All personal goals from Commission members for 2017 should be emailed to the Rec Director for review in the Feb meeting
  - e. WMS Indoor Field Hockey – proposal to purchase the barriers for indoor sport. Commission is in favor. Rec Director to confirm there will be no additional wear and tear of WMS gym floor. 50-75 sticks available from donations. Lauren Gagnon would facilitate the program for Recreation, not as a WMS sport.
  - f. Comedy Show at Roseland Park – Cost is \$750 to secure a date. Rec keeps all profits made above that expense. Plan is to hold inside the barn (100-130 occupancy) and give 10% of profits to Roseland Park. Shannon to confirm with Rick at Roseland.
  - g. Earmarked \$2,150 for Karen Paquette memorial will move forward once Jenna Demers returns from maternity leave to schedule installation of equipment at WES.
  - h. Shannon has given her notice to the Selectman that she will no longer be continuing in the role, to be finalized by the end of Feb. She will stay on while they interview and to transition the work to the new person. The Commission thanked her for her efforts and wished her well in the next endeavor. We will meet on Monday, February 13<sup>th</sup> to finalize transition through the Rec Commission and Director.
