RE: **Meeting on Draft Woodstock Aquifer Overlay and Sourcewater Protection Plan**

The Woodstock Conservation Commissions invites town representatives and the public to this meeting, to continue discussing:

- the benefits of creating an **aquifer overlay zone** over a significant underground water deposit (aquifer) in South Woodstock, and
- implementing **proactive regulations** designed to protect the water quality of this important water resource. (Certain types of land uses have the potential to very quickly degrade the water quality in this area.)
- Aquifer overlay **regulations from other towns**. (We have been working with the Atlantic States Rural Water and Wastewater Association (ASRWVA) on this project. After the first meeting, Marc Cohen of ASRWVA compiled existing aquifer overlay regulations from other towns for our review.)
